

# CAMPGROUND & ATV PARK RULES

**In order to protect the park and maintain a safe environment for people to use and enjoy the park the Village Board of the Village of Tigerton Establishes the following Rules.**

Motor vehicles licensed by WI DOT may be operated on all park and campground access roads.

ATVs may only be operated on the challenge course, ATV trails, park access roads and other designated areas.

Three wheel ATV's, minibikes, go carts and other motorized vehicles not specifically mentioned above are banned from the park.

No unauthorized person may operate any motorized vehicle in an area not designated for operation of that type of vehicle.

Current DNR ATV Registration is required for all ATVs, UTVs & OMHs in the park.

All ATV/UTV operators shall pay all required fees and sign any agreement or waiver required by the Village of Tigerton before use of the park.

No person shall operate an ATV at a speed of more than 15 mph in the park unless on the trails or challenge course.

DNR regulations on operation including youthful operators apply.

**Helmet are required for all operators.  
There shall be no double riding except of manufactured double riding machines.**

No person shall operate an ATV in an area not designated for operation.

No person shall operate an ATV in an unsafe or reckless manner.

No person shall accelerate an ATV to cause gravel or debris to be thrown from the wheels. This does not apply to the trail system or challenge course.

No person shall operate an ATV on any trail designated for bicycles or hikers.

**No ATV shall be operated in park during hours of darkness or before 8 am each morning.**

Persons must start, tend and maintain fire in personal grills and park fire rings only.

Unburned fuel or ashes shall be disposed of in such a way as to prevent fire or damage to park property.

Persons may bring their own firewood. Firewood may be purchased at the park office.

No person shall remove firewood without payment or cut any tree or bush for firewood.

No person shall burn plastic, metal, glass or other non-woody or paper object in any fireplace or ring.

No person shall leave behind any noncombustible material in any fireplace or fire ring.

Persons shall urinate or defecate only in proper facilities.

No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited any litter or rubbish in the park. All trash and recyclables shall be disposed of properly.

NO person expelled or requested to leave the park by an authorized person shall remain or enter until the expulsion has expired.

No parent, legal guardian or adult in charge of any minor child visiting the park shall allow or encourage any violation of this chapter by said minor child.

Any person that participates, encourages or promotes or knowingly helps conceal any violation of this chapter is in violation of the section or subsection violated.

Open fires may be prohibited in times of high fire danger.

No person shall use a campsite without registering and paying the require fee.

Camping is allowed only in campsites

**No unnecessary noise after 11 p.m.**

No person shall damage, alter, deface, conceal or remove any park property without prior consent.

No person shall kill, injure, disturb, or attempt to of any wild or domestic animal.

No underage drinking allowed.

No discharge of fireworks on park property allowed.

No firearms or fireworks allowed.

**All pets should be on a leash or otherwise secured so as not to injure or annoy other patrons of the park.**

Fecal matter from pets shall be disposed of properly.

Any law officer, park employee or Village board member is authorized to enforce these rules. Penalty may include expulsion from the property and may include forfeiture of \$50- \$100.
